SUBJECT: Disposition of Used Poles

POLICY:

The Cooperative routinely removes and retires electric poles that are no longer needed, have become unserviceable or are inadequate due to changes to the distribution system. Retired poles will be made available to cooperative members or members of the public in accordance with the procedure described herein.

RESPONSIBILITY: President & CEO or Delegate

PROCEDURE:

The cooperative will remove and dispose of poles in a manner that minimizes risk of injury or damage and is most cost effective. The cooperative may provide removed used poles upon formal request from a cooperative member or member of the public under the following conditions:

- A. Members of the cooperative will have preferential rights to retired poles but all poles are provided on a first come first served basis.
- B. Available poles will normally be placed at or near the field location where originally installed, or at nearby mutually agreed upon location.
- C. All used poles are provided "as is where is" without any warranties of merchantability or fitness for any use or purpose. Individuals receiving used poles assume all liability and responsibility associated with the pole(s). Responsible use and disposal information concerning used wood poles is available on our website www.claverack.com.

In place used poles that have not been physically removed but are no longer needed by the cooperative may be purchased from the cooperative. See the current Schedule of Fees, Policy B-12 for pricing information.
