INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETION OF AUTHORIZATION AGREEMENT

1. ACCOUNT TYPE: Check the appropriate box to indicate the type of account from which the funds will be withdrawn (debited). If you need assistance determining the type of account you have, contact the financial institution with which you have the account.
2. DEPOSITORY INFORMATION: Enter the name and address of the financial institution where you maintain the account that is to receive the withdrawal (debit).
3. DEPOSITORY TRANSIT/ABA NUMBER: If the account from which the withdrawal is to be made is a savings account, you will have to obtain this nine (9) digit number from your financial institution. If the account is a checking account, then this number can be found on one of your checks at the bottom left. (PLEASE SEE SAMPLE CHECK.)
4. ACCOUNT NUMBER: Enter the full account number for the account from which the funds are to be withdrawn. (SEE SAMPLE CHECK FOR THE LOCATION OF YOUR CHECKING ACCOUNT NUMBER.)
5. MEMBER INFORMATION AND SIGNATURE: Please print your full name, enter the current date and sign.
